

Summary Notice

Crawford v. Thyssenkrupp Materials NA, Inc., No. 2122-CC00411 (Cir. Ct. St. Louis, MO)

A proposed settlement has been reached in the above-entitled class action lawsuit. The lawsuit alleges that around December 28, 2020, Defendants experienced a Data Incident in which tk Materials' computer systems were encrypted in a ransomware attack that involved a compromise of the personally identifiable information of certain of its current and former employees. Records indicate you are included.

Settlement Benefits. If you do not opt out of the Settlement, you may be entitled to receive Settlement benefits by submitting a Claim Form no later than **March 8, 2023**, which you can obtain online at www.CrawfordClassAction.com or by calling **1-877-750-0348**. If eligible, you may submit a claim for two years of free credit monitoring and identity theft protection services (including \$1,000,000 in identity theft insurance) offered through TransUnion Interactive's *myTrueIdentity* service, and you may submit a claim for Ordinary Losses (\$200 max), Lost Time (\$25/hr, 6 hrs/\$150 max), and Extraordinary Losses (\$8,000 max) you experienced related to the Data Incident. If valid claims exceed \$750,000 payments will be reduced pro rata. For Class Members who already enrolled in 2021 in the identity theft protection services offered by Defendants, your enrollment will automatically be extended by one year, from two to three years of services. More information is included on the Claim Form.

Your Options. You can do nothing and claim no benefits, submit a Claim Form to claim benefits, object to the Settlement or any part of it, or opt out of the Settlement. If you do anything but opt out, you will give up the right to sue Defendants on the issues covered by the Settlement. If you opt out, you will retain the right to sue, but you will not be eligible to receive any of the benefits of the Settlement. Objections or opt out requests must be postmarked no later than January 23, 2023.

Final Approval Hearing. The Court will hold a final approval hearing on February 27, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. at 10 N. Tucker Blvd., St. Louis, MO 63101. The Court will decide at the hearing whether the Settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate. The Court will also consider a request for attorneys' fees and expenses of \$435,000 and service awards of \$3,500 each to the two plaintiffs, paid by Defendant in addition to the other Settlement benefits.
